Garofoli Verdicchio, “Podium,” Marche, Italy 2022	65
Calcium rich hillside; low yield fruit. Classic aromas & flavors of fennel, almond, & antique apple. Broad, dry palate with Chablis-like stoniness.	
Dog Point Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 2024	64
Dry farmed, heritage clone. Tender, but incisive. Grapefruit and mineral, tangy richness with a hint of smoke and a Gallic temperament.	
Patricia Green Rosé “Helen Dusschee,” Freedom Hill Vineyard, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2023	58
Tempranillo. Young vines grown on Bellpine loam. Dry and gentle, with hidden acidity and flavors of nectarine and raspberry. Serene but dewy.	
Occhipinti “SP 68,” Sicily, Italy 2024	65
Skin-contact Muscat. Effusive, yet down-to-earth floral with barely ripe peach flavors and a heart warming texture.

Château de Fieuzal, Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France 2018	110
Grands Cru Classé. Cabernet and Merlot. Black currants, cedar. Expansive, refined palate with cool tannins. Urbane and polished. Alain Delon.	
Altos las Hormigas Malbec “Reserve,” Valle de Uco, Mendoza, Argentina 2021	65
100% Malbec grown on gravel. Focused black fruits, with cocoa and hard spice accents. Dry but plentiful.	
John Duval “Plexus,” Barossa Valley, Australia, 2020	92
Shiraz, Grenache, and Mourvèdre. Oodles of black fruit, with olive and mocha notes. Full but not ponderous. Panoramic.	
St. Innocent Pinot Noir “Momtazi Vineyard,” McMinville, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2019	100
Textural and umami, yet elegant. Aromas of spice, smoky earth, and dried black fruit. Hints of cocoa powder on the finish.	
Viña Sastre “Reserva,” Ribera del Duero, Spain 2018	88
La Horra fruit. Powerful, burnished, yet elegant. Savory black fruit with spice, leather, and cedar notes. Judiciously oaked.
